## **CHANGES TO THE CLUB CALENDAR FOR 2025**

**The following were all agreed by the committee**

- To replace the 12 monthly medal competitions with 4 seasonal medals



- To rearrange the calendar to ensure named competitions aren't played on the same weekends as matches
- To approach Cophorne Vets for an annual match
- To initiate an annual Vice-Captain's Day
- To introduce a Committee Day competition
- To introduce a Summer Classic competition (diary permitting)
- To give a prize to the best eclectic score each year
- To introduce a midweek league for those playing on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday or Friday
- To move as many named competitions to spring and summer as possible
- To make Stableford competitions in December and January 9-hole instead of 18
- To extend the Bolster and Phil Patterson Cup competitions to be played over 10 weeks instead of 8, with the best 6 scores counting towards the player's total points
